The dunes of Maspalomas, the picturesque Puerto de Mogán and the Guanche caves

The incredible dunes with the ocean behind are a must-see if you are visiting Gran Canaria. Enjoy the breathtaking views and take some selfies before continuing to Puerto Mogán. This town, also known as "Little Venice" for its bridges and canals, is another highlight of this island. A former fishing village, it is today one of the most picturesque tourist enclaves of Gran Canaria. Enjoy its marina or just strolling through its narrow streets full of colorful bougainvillea and charming white houses. We will then visit the village of Agüimes, with its emblematic sculptures, before entering the Guayadeque ravine, a place where the ancient Canary Islanders lived in caves and where there are still families living in cave houses. We will have lunch in a restaurant built in a cave and before returning we will stop at the Caldera de Bandama, the last active volcano on the island that erupted 2000 years ago, from where we will contemplate fantastic views over the volcanic crater and the city of Las Palmas de Gran Canaria.
